Costs incurred so far:

GBC mail out, to every person on the electoral role, in the parish 2977 voters \pounds 2589 (Estimated mail out costs 2^{nd} class post at 87 p per letter - It might have been more)

Costs of 2977 envelopes, and 8 printed pages, paper and ink estimated \pounds 500

Cost of officers time, not possible to calculate but there is a cost.

Shere Parish council costs, so far:

Mail out to each household in the parish, 1750 approx at £1.70 per household. £3000

Paper, ink, envelopes, 2 pages, estimated £250

Time spent by clerk, and councillors, to print, insert and post out, cost not known,

But there is a cost

Total then so far £6114

This is an estimate, time cannot be calculated, these funds are lost to the precept, ie it comes out of what the parish has to spend, for the year, so this represents approx. 6% of the budget available this year. This also comes out partly from our council tax.

What an absolute waste!

Add to this the cost of holding an election normally £5000, plus cost of the hall for voting approx £40 at a guess. So lets add that on , it would be then over £11000, wasted. This is not factored in the proposed costs as presented
